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## WHAT IS A "SKILL"?

A "skill" is a piece of expertise normally gained by acquiring the knowledge, skills, and behaviors associated with a particular occupation. "Skill competition" refers to any vocational skill competition, which is based on one or more occupations for which there is a benchmark, description, or standard. The skill competitions are referenced to occupations, since these are internationally understood, associated with a career, and have longevity.

The project encourages VET schools and local businesses to initiate practical vocational skills competitions at local and regional levels.
